












Conditions of Entry

All entrants are required to hold third party indemnity insurance with a minimum indemnity limit of $\pounds 2,000,000$ (two million pounds GBP) for the total period of the event and may be asked to provide proof to the event organisers.

Sailors under 18yrs require a responsible guardian during the event.

Registration & Briefing

All participants to register at the Windsport Event Office. Registration opens:- Sunday 21st 16.00 – 18.00hrs & Monday 22nd 9.00-10-00hrs

Sailing Instructions and briefing details will be issued at Registration.

Liability Declaration

(The term "boat" refers to sailors and their equipment) 1 A boat is entirely responsible for her own safety, whether afloat or ashore, and nothing, whether in the event instructions or anywhere else, reduces this responsibility.

2 It is for the boat to decide whether she is fit to sail in the conditions in which she will find herself. By launching, the boat confirms that she is fit for those conditions and competent to sail or compete in them.

3 Nothing done by the event organisers can reduce the responsibility of the boat nor will it make the event organisers responsible for any loss, damage, death or personal injury, however it may have occurred, as a result of the boat taking part. The event organisers encompass everyone helping to run the event including a race committee, patrol boats and beach masters 4 The provision of patrol boats does not relieve the boat of her responsibilities.

5 Parents or guardians of competitors under 18 yrs are required to take full responsibility for their dependants throughout the event and sign the parental declaration at registration. The person accepting this responsibility shall be present for the duration of the event.
