Entries received by midnight Sunday 31<sup>st</sup> May: Discounted Entry fee: £150

Entries from Mon 1<sup>st</sup> June to Tue 23<sup>rd</sup> June: Full Entry fee: £175

Advanced entries only – entry will close at 5pm on Tuesday 23<sup>rd</sup> June.

Entry includes nine races, glassware and prizes, Friday evening meal and Class Association Dinner.

Polo Shirts (turquoise) also be ordered with entries received by 31<sup>st</sup> May - at an extra cost of £20 each.

There are discounts for youth and first time nationals entries. On receipt of your entry, you will receive confirmation of how to pay via BACS.

## Accommodation

### Camping, motorhomes, campervans:

Free onsite parking is available for camping, motorhomes and campervans. In order to fit everyone in – please note the following:

- Please book your space when entering
- No awnings, gazebos, outside seating areas etc permitted as need to fit everyone in
- There are no hook up facilities. A black / chemical waste point is available.
- Cars and road trailers will not be allowed in the camping/campervan areas.

There are a range of other accommodation options available in the local area. The nearest towns are: Burnham on Crouch – approx. 20 mins away, a number of pubs have good accommodation here.

Maldon – approx 30 mins drive away – a number of pubs with rooms plus a Travelodge.

Air bnb and some other accommodation is available closer to the club – just ensure you book something

**ON THE RIGHT (SOUTH) SIDE OF THE RIVER!** Otherwise you will have a long drive round. Places to look for include Steeple, Mayland, Bradwell, Tillingham, Latchingdon, Southminster etc.
